
AGE & HEALTH REQUIREMENTS

PROOF OF AGE – PRESCHOOL & KINDERGARTEN

- K3 students must be three (3) years old and toilet-trained before enrolling.
- K4 students must be four (4) years old before enrolling.
- Kindergarten students must be five (5) years old on or before August 31st.
- All students must submit a state-issued birth certificate. A copy must be on file in the student's personal record in the school office.

HEALTH RECORDS

The following are requirements for school attendance (Preschool through grade 12):

- DTP-DTaP-DT-DTP/Hib-Td Four doses, one of which was given on or after the fourth birthday. If age 7 or older, three doses are required.
- Polio (OPV/IPV) Four doses of OPV or IPV. If the third dose was given on or after the fourth birthday, the fourth dose is not required. However, if a combination of IPV/OPV (2IPV/2oPV) is used; all four doses are needed regardless of age.
- MMR One dose must be given on or after the first birthday. A second dose of MMR is required for attendance in all grades.
- Hepatitis B Three doses required for entrance into kindergarten.
- Varicella (Chickenpox) Proof of immunization or a history of the disease is required prior to entry into kindergarten.
- Physical Examination

Immunizations may be obtained from the family physician or County Health Department. Student's records must be signed and dated by the health provider (doctor or health department).

All required forms must be submitted to the school office before students may attend class.
